English - Spellings

As spellers, we will be following the Read, Write, Inc spelling programme which will cover all of the spelling rules and patterns for the Year 3 curriculum. lists.

English

As readers, we will be studying: Varmints Heart in a Bottle

As writers, we will be learning how to:

Write for different purposes - to retell, entertain, inform, instruct, and persuade.

Use commas for clarity.
Use fronted adverbials to open sentences.

Explore word classes including adverbs.

Use synonyms to improve our writing.

Maths

As Mathematicians, we will learn:

Fractions – addition and subtraction of fractions with the same denominator, equivalent fractions with different denominators.

Time – Read and write analogue to the nearest minute, 12 and 24 hour.

Statistics – interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables.

Science

As Scientists, we will learn about Light and Shadow.

We will learn:

How we need light in order to see. How light travels.

About the Sun as a light source. Identify the difference between night and day.

What shadows are.

How the length and position of a shadow changes throughout the day. How light is reflected from surfaces.

As Historians, we will learn about **The Iron Age**. We will interpret a range of evidence to generate reasons, and then explain, why Iron Age Britain was often a violent time.

History

As Geographers, we will learn what **sustainability** entails and how we might approach applying those principles to our own lives. We will study renewable and non-renewable resources.

Geography

As Sportspeople, we will work as a team and develop our striking and fielding in Rounders and Cricket, further develop our skills in Dance and work on our orienteering in OAA.

DE

As Coders, the **We are Opinion Pollsters** topic will teach us how to use Google forms to create our own opinion poll, seek responses and analyse the results.

Computing

As Theologises, we will learn about **Signs and Symbols**. We will explore some common signs and symbols to get us thinking about the meanings behind symbolism.
