English

As readers we will be studying:
King Kong
The Three Little Pigs

As Writers, we will be writing to entertain, inform, persuade, argue/discuss and recount. We will produce a job advertisement, a job application, a story, a discussion text and a play script.
We will link ideas across paragraphs using a wider range of cohesive devices, use layout devices to structure text and use the passive voice within our writing.

Maths

As Mathematicians we will learn:

Geometry

Shape - properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Position and Direction -Position in all 4 quadrants including **translation** and **reflection**.

Properties of Numbers – Revision.

Multi-step problems in all contexts.

Science

As Scientists, we learn about **changing circuits**. We will explore how to change the brightness of a bulb/loudness of a buzzer, how different wires affect a circuit and how to use symbols in a circuit diagram. We will also study a topic called **seeing light**. We will explore shadows and how they behave, how our eyes see and reflections.

As spellers we will be learning the following rules and patterns:

As Historians, we will learn about 'The Shang Dynasty' including: oracle bones, the beliefs of Shang rulers, what life was like for people in different sections of Shang society, King Cheng Tang and Di Xin and Fu Hao

History

As Geographers, we will learn why fair trade is fair. We will learn what international trade entails, and the history of trade. We will look at what the UK imports and exports.

Geography

As Sportspeople, we will learn the skills required to play cricket, rounders and tennis. We will apply these skills in competitive games. We will also perform dances using a range of movement patterns in our Dance topic.

PE

As Coders, we will learn about sensing in our **Programming B** topic. We will also learn about copyright & ownership, managing online information and privacy & security in our online safety topic.

Computing

As Theologians we will learn '**Expressing Faith Through the Arts.**' We will find out how, why and when music, drama and art are used in religions around the world.

RE

As Citizens we will learn about '**Knife Crime**' and how to keep ourselves safe, discuss **transition** to secondary school and explore '**How can I make a change?**'

PSHE

As Musicians, we will learn to sing and perform through our end of year school performance and leavers' service. We will also compose and perform a leavers song during a Handbells workshop.

Music

As linguists we will be developing our listening, speaking, reading and writing skills in French through the topics '**Numbers 1-100**' and '**Jobs and Future**'.

French

As designers we will learn about '**Fairgrounds**'. We will examine a variety of rotating fairground rides before designing and making our own ride using an electrical motor.
