English

In English & Phonics we are covering the Read, Write, Inc programme.
As Readers, we will work our way through the programme, learning set 1, set 2 and then set 3 sounds. We will read a range of books with words containing our taught sounds in our daily English lessons.
As Spellers, we will recall learnt sounds and segment to spell words. We will follow the speed sounds word programme and Word Time as appropriate to the different levels.
As Writers, we will be learning to use these sounds to spell words. We will develop our sentences to include capital letters, full stops and gaps.

Maths

Counting – Counting to 100 in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s.
Multiplication and division – solve one step problems using concrete objects and pictorial representations and arrays.
Fractions – To recognise, find and name a half and a quarter in shape and quantity.
Position and direction – describe position and direction in movements, whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns.
Money – Recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes.
Time – To sequence events in chronological order and to the language relating to days, weeks, months, and years.

Science

As Scientists, we will identify and name a variety of common animals. We will learn about the classification of animals and have an understanding of how to care for animals.

We will study a variety of plants in the season of Summer. We will find out about what plants need and grow our own plants and care for them.

As Historians, we will learn about famous explorers and their lives at various points in the past. We will reflect on their achievements and the challenges they faced.

History

As Geographers, we will learn about weather and how it affects our lives. We study different types of weather, the seasons and how weather is different in different parts of the world.

Geography

As Sports people, we will practice running, hitting and catching as well as developing our hand-eye coordination. We will also practise sending and returning and practise these skills during competitive games.

PE

As Coders, we will learn about grouping data and information. We will use labels to put objects into groups and use our ability to sort objects to answer questions about data.

Computing

As Theologises, we ask ourselves 'What do Muslims Celebrate?' We will learn about the Islamic religion and discover Muslim celebrations.

RE

As Citizens, we will learn to explore our community and focus on litter through 'The picnic'. We will discuss rules under the heading 'you can't do that'.

PSHE

As Musicians, we will learn and use musical vocabulary in our 'under the sea' piece. We will practise singing and body sounds during our 'by the sea' piece of music.

Music

As Linguists, we will learn to name the various colours in French. We will develop our listening, speaking and reading skills following repetition, recognition and recall.

French

As Designers, we will learn to design, make and evaluate a recipe using fruit/vegetables. We will examine, taste and describe a variety of fruit and vegetables.

DT

As Artists, we will be exploring African art. We will explore colours and patterns of the African landscape. We will create patterns, explore the Massai culture and create African sunsets.
